President's Message

Work has already started on the trails for the upcoming season. A considerable amount of trail brushing has to be done this year to accommodate the anticipation of a larger groomer in the area, as well as keeping the brush well back for better view.

We have established there is a road allowance known as the Noe Rd extension running north, connecting up to the Newman road (formerly Pruner Rd) running east which will allow us to re-open E105 through to E113 to the rail line, instead of having to go south to the 401 and then north again. We are working with the district and the OFSC to hopefully get some funding to help out this cost.

Over the next few weeks excluding the two weeks of deer hunting, we hope to get much of the maintenance work done. Once all the farm fields are clear we will begin our signage.

The sale of Trail Permits does not alone cover the cost of maintaining our trail system and the numerous other expenses incurred on an annual basis by your local snowmobile club. We are fortunate in that we have volunteers that help organize and schedule various fundraisers to help offset costs, but we could use more help especially when most of the current volunteers are seniors.

You will see from the trail permit prices as shown below, there are no increases in prices for the upcoming snowmobile season over last year. The Classic Trail Permit was received extremely well again last year. The same rules apply this year as last with any sled, 1999 or older only requires the Classic Trail Permit.

Show your support for snowmobiling, volunteer or bring your friends and attend a fundraiser. Remember, trails are brought to you by volunteers.
