The season has been kicked off with the replacement of two bridges, one on G50 west of Limerick, and the second on E105 east of Shannon Farms. Several weeks were spent brushing and widening E113, taking advantage of the new chipper recently purchased by the LGSA.

We are taking from November 5<sup>th</sup> to Nov 17<sup>th</sup> off, due to deer hunting season, and will be continuing with trail clearance and putting up signage Nov 19<sup>th</sup>. We would welcome any volunteers that would like to help out on the trails, as well as anyone who would enjoy working in the clubhouse. If you would like to help on trails, we meet at the clubhouse at 9 a.m. each day the weather is good, and enough members are available. Our fundraising activities include a number of catered dinners, and we have euchres every Wednesday night which are well attended. We will also be selling tickets for the District Raffle. This year's prize is a 2012 Yamaha Venture Lite, a 2012 Yamaha Phazer GT and a 2012 Triton 11' fully enclosed trailer. The value of this package is \$21,450. Tickets are \$5.00 each, and our club will be at the Canadian Tire Store, Prescott, on December 7 and 8<sup>th</sup>, and 14 and 15<sup>th</sup>. If anyone is interested in helping sell tickets, we would be happy to hear from you. Grenville Club keeps \$2.50 from each ticket as a fundraiser.

Full Season permit (up to and including Dec 1/12)	\$210.00
Full Season permit (after Dec 1/12)	\$260.00
Classic permits (sleds 1998 or earlier)	\$130.00
7 Day permit	\$140.00
3 Day permit	\$100.00

While we realize a number of riders are taking advantage of buying their permits on line, and the OFSC is pushing on line sales, we are not. Why are we not pushing on line sales? Well, for one reason. The OFSC is taking an extra \$6.00 out of our local clubs and off our local trails for every permit purchased on line. The OFSC is indicating that they will give you a \$5.00 off the usual administration fee this year, but don't tell you, your club is being charged an extra \$6.00. Thus we recommend you purchase your permits at an outlet, or from a club member.

When you purchase your permit, if you have a computer and go online, please fill in your email address, so we can keep you advised of what is happening in snowmobiling, and eventually, we hope to send this newsletter to each of you via email. This will save a substantial amount of postage. Also, go into our website noted above for all club events.

Our club recently was the recipient of a grant from our local EODP for approximately two thirds the cost of a new furnace/air conditioner which will be installed in the clubhouse before the end of November. The present system is the original which makes it 22 years old, and past its life expectancy. We were also able to obtain a Hydro grant to change all the lighting in the clubhouse in late October. The club members also installed a new red steel roof on the garage in late September.
